Regular Trash, Refuse and Garbage Disposal

Our neighborhood is serviced by three private trash haulers:

The haulers normally bill on a quarterly basis. Trash containers (totes) are available. They all follow the same holiday policy. They recognize the same six holidays, i.e., New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas. There is no service on these holidays. When the holiday falls on a trash pick-up day, the schedule is delayed a day. Severe weather that prevents a scheduled pick-up will add a day's delay to the rest of the week.

Bath Township Recycling

Only recyclable paper, cardboard, glass, plastic and metal can be dropped off at the Bath Township Hall (west side parking area), 2880 Ada Road, Lima, OH the <u>Third Thursday</u> of each month from 2:30 p.m. to 5:00p.m. <u>DO NOT</u> <u>DROP OFF RECYCABLES BEFORE 2:30 P.M.</u> For more information contact the Bath Township Office at Phone: 419-221-1797.

Neighborhood Clean-up

CCHTL has its semi-annual Neighborhood Clean-up Days in early May and September. We partner with the Allen Soil and Water Conservation District's Adopt-A-Roadway (Neighborhood) Program. We encourage all neighbors to keep their property neat, tidy and free of litter throughout the year. We expect people walking their dogs to be responsible proper pooper picker uppers. Bath Township Trash Clean-up Day

Bath Township has an annual Clean-up Day usually held in early summer. This is a <u>FREE</u> service offered to all Bath Township residents and property owners (be prepared to confirm your residency). Dumpsters are provided where all sorts of trash (including old tires) can be dropped off. <u>FREE</u> towing of unwanted junk cars is available. For more information call the Bath Township Office at Phone: 419-221-1797. <u>DO NOT BRING ANY</u> <u>GARBAGE OR HAZARDOUS WASTE, such as paint, oil, solvents, batteries</u> or any chemical of any kind. You must take these items back home with you.

Hazardous and Electronic Waste

Arrangements for hazardous waste disposal can be made by calling the North Central Ohio Solid Waste District at Phone: 419-228-8278 or visit their website: <u>www.ncowaste.org</u>. They are located at 815 Shawnee Road, Lima, OH. They will charge for this service, normally a fee of \$1.00 per pound. Disposal of electronic waste such as electrical equipment, cameras, printers, VCRs, DVD players, cell phones, scanners, copiers, stereos, Walkman's, iPods, MP3 players, radios, and CBs, WILL BE ACCEPTED AT NO CHARGE. The charge for TV sets and computer monitors is \$0.12 per pound.

Natural Wood, Brush, Grass and Leaf Debris

Resource Recycling will accept natural wood and brush (no construction waste) as well as grass and leaves at their facility located at 1596 Neubrecht Road, Lima, OH. Their hours are Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 8:00 to noon. There is no charge for this disposal. For more information call 419-222-2702.

Bath Township Annual Leaf Pick-up

Starting the first week in November each year the Bath Township Road Crew begins its annual leaf pick-up program. The Road Crews will be in each neighborhood at least two days per week. The program ends the day before Thanksgiving. Residents are asked to rake the leaves to the edge of the road or on the sidewalk side of the curb, <u>NOT</u> onto the street. Leaves in the street are illegal and cause drainage problems. In our CCHTL neighborhood, DO NOT bag your leaves. DO NOT put sticks or other trash in the leaves. It jams the equipment which causes damage and delays. Bath residents in rural areas of the township must contact the Township Office at 419-221-1791 for leaf pick-up.
