In spite of the Covide-19 restrictions, last year was financially good for our neighborhood association. Our September Neighborhood Impact Week Membership Drive was a great success! We added 48 dues paying members. Over 42 percent of our 500 households supported our neighborhood. We received \$2,750 in grants and awards. Also, we received two \$500 donations. Our annual expenses are basically fixed and tend to go up a little each year. Your continuing support is greatly appreciated. Homes in our neighborhood are selling quickly and sellers are receiving good prices. We have a significant number of new neighbors. Please welcome these newcomers. Lost Creek Property Development

The Lost Creek property development adjacent to our neighborhood is moving forward. Tony Collins a local business man and Bath High School graduate who purchased the Lost Creek Country Club property provided this update. The building plans to construct 15 new single-family homes ranging in size between 1,800 to 2,200 square feet along Lost Creek Blvd. (formerly the 1st and 2nd fairways of the golf course) have been submitted to the Lima-Allen County Regional Planning Commission (LACRPC). Mr. Collins hopes for a decision this month. If things go well, he would start construction in May. Later this summer he has plans to renovate the Club House and Restaurant. In 2022, he plans to create an Executive Golf Course on the remaining property. He is in favor of keeping the property totally in Bath Township. For this reason the City of Lima is postponing the \$1.5 million Lost Creek Wetlands Restoration and Trail Improvement Project for the Lost Creek property.

Ottawa River Bike/Walkway Connector to CCHTL

We regret to inform you that the Ottawa River Bike/Walkway Connector to our CCHTL neighborhood has been postponed. The Project Stakeholders were able to determine the best one and half mile path along Roush and Reservoir Roads. The preliminary plans and cost estimates were prepared. Initial discussions were conducted with the CSX Railroad regarding the railroad crossing at Roush Road. Property acquisition and/or access were discussed with the owners. The Bike/Walkway connector and its extension to The Ohio State University and Rhodes State University campus remain on the long range plans of the Lima-Allen County Regional Planning Commission and have its strong support. The Johnny Appleseed Metro Park Director is willing to sponsor and support the Allen County portion of the path. Although the City of Lima supports the project, they do not currently have the funds available to complete the portion of the path that would be on city property. Also, the City of Lima will be changing its administrative leadership this year and they may want to pursue different priorities. If this project were easy, it would have already been built.
