### **Dog Control Concerns**

BE ALERT! There have been reported incidents of dog attacks in our neighborhood, specifically on Fenway and Sunnymeade Drives. Neighbors have been chased and bitten. The Ohio Revised Code requires all dogs to be licensed. The law states that "No owner, keeper, or harborer of any dog shall fail at any time to keep it either physically confined or restrained upon the premises of the owner, keeper, or harborer by a leash, tether, adequate fence, supervision or secure except when the dog is lawfully engaged in hunting accompanied by the owner, keeper or harborer." Dogs must be controlled. Dog owners will be held responsible. You should immediately report vicious or dangerous dog control situations to the Allen County Sheriff's Office at Phone: 419-227-3535. You should leave a voice mail message to report non-urgent dog control situations to the Allen County Dog Warden at phone: 419-228-3700 ext. 8528. You can take a picture of a dog running-at-large as evidence for the Dog Warden. We expect all dog owners to be good neighbors and comply with the law.

### **Important Neighborhood Information**

The Bath Township Trustees and Road Crew have been taking excellent care of the streets in our neighborhood. Although there is no scheduled road work for our neighborhood this summer, you should report "pot holes" or other street problems to the Bath Township Office at Phone: 419-221-1797. Bath Township Trustees continue to make annual payments to pay off the bonds used to completely reconstruct Fenway Drive. Last year the Bath Township Road Crew improved the drainage basin at the intersection of Yorkshire and Barnsbury Drives, which eliminated the pond (and ice) forming at the northwest corner of the intersection. The Allen County Drainage Engineers repaired broken drainage tiles and removed debris from Lost Creek. We appreciate the improvements made to our neighborhood. We will actively seek future road and infrastructure improvements.

A new home is coming to our neighborhood. Anthony and Channie Mikesell are building a new house on the corner of Heritage and Yorkshire Drives. Please welcome them to our neighborhood!
