Free Parking in the Park. Prizes and Trophies: 1^{st} Place -40% of Registration Fees, 2^{nd} Place -20% of Registration Fees and 3^{rd} Place -10% of Registration Fees.

Junior Competition: Participants age 12 and under. FREE with parental permission. Teams will have Double Elimination. Trophies: 1st Place and 2nd Place.

CCHTL National Night Out – Valley Way Park

Our seventh annual CCHTL National Night Out (NNO) was another success! It was held on August 6th at our CCHTL Valley Way Park and Shelter House. National Night Out is a nation-wide program to promote crime prevention, fire safety, police-community partnerships and neighborhood camaraderie. NNO has grown to involve over 37 million people in 15,000 communities from all fifty states. Allen County Sheriff Matthew Treglia is now organizing a larger NNO event at the Allen County Fairgrounds, which includes our Bath Township Fire Department. To avoid future conflicts, we may hold our own "Picnic in the Park" on a different date.

Over 50 neighbors attended. The weather was beautiful and everyone had a good time. It was a festival of fun! Children were playing on the swing sets and running around the park, laughing and have a good time. The adults had a chance to talk with old friends and meet new neighbors. It was a perfect opportunity to get to know your neighbors better, which directly leads to a safer neighborhood for everyone. Special thanks go to Craig Kohli who was the Chairperson for the event as well as Dianne Carter and Bob Birkemeier who helped prepare the hamburgers, hot dogs and took care of all the logistics and clean-up. We want to recognize, Berkshire Hathaway Realty, who graciously sponsored the event and provided the FREE food and drinks. CCHTL supplied the chips and cookies.





We are so proud of the tremendous improvements in our Valley Way Park. After the park finally dried out from all the rain, Joshua Foster, Allen County Ditch Maintenance Supervisor, his staff and the contractor, Master Mowers successful completed their erosion control project along Lost Creek. They added additional "D" Rock along the creek bank, leveled the entire area and put grass seed on all of the exposed ground. Also, Allen County paid the balance of the cost to re-asphalt the walking path from Fenway Drive to the Shelter House.

The re-asphalting of the walking path was made possible because of a \$2,000 Activate Allen County Grant. CCHTL was one of only three non-profit organizations to receive these funds. In addition, we are totally grateful to Dick and Dee Dee Snider who donated the new children's

swing set and slide to our park. Our neighborhood kids have already put it to good use. Also, we want to acknowledge Roy and Esther Baldridge who donated 20 tons of Limestone for the driveway entrance into Valley Way Park as well as Joe Watson from National Lime & Stone Company who leveled the driveway at no charge.
