The West Central Association of Realtors MLS, as compiled by Craig Kohli, Berkshire Hathaway Realty reports that during the last six months, 53 homes have been sold in Bath Township. The average sales price was \$119,442 and the average listing was on the market for 128 days.

According to Kirk Slusher, ODOT District 1 Deputy Director, the traffic lights on the reconstructed parts of Harding Highway (State Route 309) and State Route 81 at the I-75 Interchange will be changed. ODOT has successfully sued the original sub-contractor, because the traffic lights did not meet specifications. The new traffic lights will improve the ability to make left turns and the sequencing of lights to improve traffic flow. The new system will use radar to detect vehicles and manage the traffic movements. The old system uses video, which sometimes fails to "see" some cars and motorcycles.
