<u>CCHTL National Night Out</u>

Our fifth annual CCHTL National Night Out (NNO) was another great success! It was held on August 1st at our CCHTL Valley Way Park and Shelter House. National Night Out is a nation-wide program to promote crime prevention, fire safety, police-community partnerships and neighborhood camaraderie. NNO has grown to involve over 37 million people in 15,000 communities from all fifty states.



Our NNO event was a wonderful success with over 120 neighbors in attendance. The weather was beautiful and everyone had a good time. Allen County Sheriff Matthew Treglia, our Bath Township Deputies and the K-9 Unit attended the event. The Bath Township Fire Department actively participated. Fire Chief, Joe Kitchen and his fireman provided fire safety instruction and educational activities. The most popular activity was the inflatable bouncy house and the opportunity to use a fire hose to extinguish "imaginary" fires on a plywood house. The firemen distributed blue plastic fire hats and stickers to the children. Adults received information for FREE Fire Detectors from the American Red Cross.

We greatly appreciate the live music and entertainment provided by Doug Adams. It was a festival of fun! Children were playing on the swing set and running around the park, laughing and having a good time. The adults had a chance to talk with old friends and meet new neighbors. It's a perfect opportunity to get to know your neighbors better, which directly leads to a safer neighborhood for everyone. Special thanks go to Craig Kohli who was the Chairperson for the event and Tim Parker, who cooked hamburgers, hot dogs and took care of all the logistics and clean-up. CCHTL Trustee Recruitment

At our January Neighborhood Meeting, the new Board nominates and elects its four officers. We will have at least two new openings on the board for next year, including the need for a new Treasurer. The Board keeps the meetings to a minimum and meets on the last Monday of the odd numbered months. This is important neighborhood work, but does not take a lot of time. We need You! Damage to our Devonshire Gateway

On August 1st, a vehicle crashed into the eastside masonry wall of our Devonshire Gateway. Although there was significant damage done to the wall, the young driver was not injured. It was a simple accident caused by the loss of control while making a left hand turn. Our Butterfield Insurance Agency has been extremely helpful in handling our accident claim. Gass Masonry Restoration has been authorized to make the necessary repairs, which will begin very soon. Special thanks go to Ted Nusbaum who did the preliminary clean-up at the site and moved the broken masonry off the lawn and cleared the sidewalk.

State of Ohio -- Charitable Registration

On September 11, 1972 the State of Ohio granted Articles of Incorporation to the Country Club Hills Home Owners Association. The Twin Lakes Home Owners Association formed a non-profit organization on September 2, 1976 and merged with CCH on January 8, 1990. The U.S. Internal Revenue Service (IRS) granted CCHTL Neighborhood Association not-for-profit, 501(c)(3) status on July 8, 2003. CCHTL has faithfully filed all Certificates of Continued Existence with the State of Ohio and all annual tax returns with the federal IRS.

On May 25, 2017, we received a letter from the Ohio Attorney General's Office (OAG) informing CCHTL that there is a State of Ohio requirement for 501(c)(3) organizations to complete an online Charitable Registration. The next day, the Charitable Registration was completed and the 2016 Annual Report submitted. Because we have assets in excess of \$25,000 there is a \$50 fee. I requested an exemption.

Although our budget is limited (annual income of \$5,000 to \$8,000 with losses reported for two of the past three years), we do have two properties which are property tax exempt. Our Valley Way Park is 4.21 acres and is assessed in value by the Allen County Auditor's Office at \$31,500. The problem with the park is that it periodically floods. Our Fenway Green Space is 1.29 acres and is assessed in value of \$8,900. However, this property has deed restrictions that require all adjacent property owners to agree to any changes or improvements, which makes it unsaleable. The total assessed value of our properties is \$41,400, which puts CCHTL over the asset limits.

The OAG determined that CCHTL was <u>NOT EXEMPT</u> from registering under the Charitable Trust Act and would need to file Annual Reports and the \$50 annual fee for 2014 through 2016. This action was completed on June 28, 2017 and the OAG assessed CCHTL \$400 in late filing penalties. We promptly requested abatement from the penalty based on our faithful reporting in the past and our immediate response to the OAG notification. The OAG waived the penalty, but we will need to file our Annual Charitable Registration Report in the future.

Little Free Library at our Shelter House

We plan to partner with the Lima Rotary Club and the Lima City Schools to bring a "Little Free Library" to our Valley Way Park Shelter House. This is part of a national program to promote reading and

literacy. These small outdoor structures (libraries) have been placed at various locations throughout the City of Lima and have been very well received. The plan is to expand the libraries to the Allen County Townships. Our Shelter House would provide an ideal place to sit and enjoy reading a book. The concept is to make books available for people to read. Anyone can visit the library and take a book and/or leave a book. The idea is to share the joy and value of reading. Little Free Libraries work on an honor system. There are no library cards or late fees.

2017 Bath Township Road Work

The Bath Township Trustees and Road Crew have been taking excellent care of the streets in our neighborhood. This year the following streets in our neighborhood will be sealed (tar & chip): Fenway Drive (from Reservoir Road to Valley Way), Canyon Drive (from Fenway Drive to the Golf Course) and Greenbriar Court. The sealing will be done after the road crews have sealed and dura-patched the problem areas. You should report "pot holes" or other street problems to the Bath Township Office at Phone: 419-221-1797.
