Special Speakers at our March Neighborhood Meeting

At our upcoming March 27th Neighborhood Meeting, Autumn Swanson, Neighborhood Specialist from the City of Lima and Thom Mazur, Director of the Regional Planning Commission will attend and share insights about our community and plans for the future. This is your chance to discuss important neighborhood issues and voice your concerns.

Ottawa River Bikeway Connector

We have some bad news about the Ottawa River Bikeway (at Roush Road) Connector to the CCHTL neighborhood (at Kingswood Drive). Although Kevin Haver, Director of Johnny Appleseed Metropolitan Park District supports the project, he has been informed by the project engineers that it is not financially feasible.

There is insufficient right-of-way at the railroad crossing on Roush Road, which would cost thousands of dollars to acquire. The cost of reconstruction of the intersection at Roush and Reservoir Roads would be \$850,000. The actual construction cost of the half mile Bikeway connector would be \$792,588. However, the biggest problems involve the Lost Creek Reservoir. The 36 inch water main that runs along Reservoir Road was installed in 1903 and it is leaking. The engineers have discovered a serious leak in the value chamber on Reservoir Road. These are very expensive repairs and replacements which would seriously compromise any possible Bikeway. In addition, the bridge on Reservoir Road over Lost Creek

(which is actually a plume structure with a significant drop in water levels) is in very poor condition and needs to be replaced at a cost of \$1 million. What appeared to be a simple Bikeway is not a realistic path.

Fortunately, the plan to connect our CCHTL neighborhood to the Ottawa River Bikeway and the Ohio State and Rhodes State campuses remains a part of the Allen County Regional Plan. Kevin is pursuing a new connector that would leave the Metro Park Bikeway from the southeast corner of the park and connect with Metzger Road. This would require a bridge over the Ottawa River and traffic signs at Metzger and Reservoir Roads to facilitate the road crossing. The Bikeway would extend west to Kingswood Drive and east to the campus. We will continue to pursue this valuable connector.

Bath Township Paramedics Need Our Help!

Fire Chief Joe Kitchen attended our January Neighborhood Meeting and requested our help. His EMS Paramedics have an extremely difficult time identifying the house numbers in our neighborhood, the toughest in Bath Township. Although we do not have many fire calls in our neighborhood, we have a large number of EMS calls. In 2016, there were 126 calls for service, that's over 10 times a month. When a Paramedic cannot find or drives past a house, precious time is lost and it could make the difference in a person's life. We need to increase our neighborhood awareness. The Chief would like to see the "Green Number Signs" available from the Bath Township Trustees (for \$10) displayed on all curbside mailboxes. Call the Bath Township Office at 419-221-1797 and order your sign today!

The Chief challenges all Bath Township residents to go outside (particularly at night) and validate that they can easily see their house number from the street. If they can't, they need to take action – the life they save maybe their own. The Chief pointed out that porch lights sometimes make it more difficult to read the house number from the street. He suggested "solar" house numbers that light themselves.
