Kingswood Street Sign Replaced

Last November, it was discovered that our CCHTL street sign at Kingswood Drive and Reservoir Road had been blown down by high winds. The post was broken off at the ground level and our sign was badly damaged. The cost of replacing the hand carved cedar sign and post was prohibitively expensive. Fortunately, our insurance coverage was able to provide an excellent replacement. Chis Fultz did a wonderful job of recreating our sign and mounting it to a new post. We greatly appreciate the Bath Township Trustees who authorized installing the new sign and we acknowledge the good work done by Denny Wilkins and his crew who installed the sign under winter conditions. Also, we gratefully thank Chris, Denny and his crew for refurbishing our street sign at Fenway Drive. Thanks Guys!

Valley Way Park Improvements

Lots of activity has been happening in our Valley Way Park. Most noticeable is the new "D" Rock erosion control placed on the bank of Lost Creek along our walking path to the shelter house. This action was necessary to protect our walking path from being "lost" in Lost Creek.

We greatly appreciate Joshua Foster, Allen County Ditch Maintenance Supervisor, his staff and the contractor, Master Mowers for all of their hard work on this project. The weather has not been cooperative and has caused numerous delays. There may be a need for more "D" Rock. The bare ground needs to be seeded and covered with straw. Also, the walking path needs to be cleared and repaired. This work will be done as soon as weather permits.

The contractor has already addressed the sink hole in the soccer field. The area will be seeded and covered with straw. Also, the old concrete pad for the flag pole has been removed. New signs have been placed in the park and a chain gate installed at our Valley Way entrance. This action was taken to help prevent vandalism in our park caused by a few thoughtless people. Thanks go to Denny Wilkins, Bath Township Road Superintendent and his crew for installing the new signs and gate.

Roy and Esther Baldridge have donated 20 tons of Limestone that will be placed on the driveway into Valley Way Park. This will greatly improve the driveway and help stop erosion of the slope leading into the park. The Limestone will be laid as soon as weather permits.

Ottawa River Bike/Walkway Connector to CCHTL

We are making progress with a Connector from the Ottawa River Bike/Walkway at the Roush Road overpass to the CCHTL and Lost Creek neighborhoods and on to The OSU and Rhodes State campuses. Kevin Haver, Director of Johnny Appleseed Metropolitan Park District continues to support the project and it remains a part of the Allen County Regional Plan. There are federal and state grant funds available. We are actively pursuing the best route to Reservoir Road. The Lima Rotary Club has given its support to the project. We wholeheartedly support this effort which would provide a safe and enjoyable bike and pedestrian path that would connect our neighborhood to the City of Lima, the universities, numerous businesses, employers, parks and provide access to other bike and walking paths.
