

Ottawa River Bike/Walkway Connector to CCHTL

We are making real progress with a Connector from the Ottawa River Bike/Walkway at the Roush Road overpass to the CCHTL and Lost Creek neighborhoods and on to The OSU and Rhodes State campus. The Lima Rotary Club has adopted this project and formed a committee to actively pursue this connector. Kevin Haver, Director of Johnny Appleseed Metropolitan Park District continues to support the project and it remains a part of the Allen County Regional Plan. We wholeheartedly support this effort which would provide a safe and enjoyable bike and pedestrian path that would connect our neighborhood to the City of Lima, the universities, numerous businesses, employers, parks and provide access to other bike and walking paths.

Recycling and Hazardous Waste Disposal

Bath Township provides monthly recycling of glass, plastic, metal and paper at the Bath Township Hall, 2880 Ada Road the third Thursday of every month from 2:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. DO NOT DROP OFF RECYCABLES BEFORE 2:30 p.m. DO NOT bring garbage, paint, oil, solvents, batteries or any chemical of any kind. You must take these items back home with you.

Resource Recycling will accept natural wood and brush (no construction waste) as well as grass and leaves at their facility located at 1596 Neubrecht Road, Lima, OH. Their hours are Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to noon. There is no charge for this disposal. For more information call 419-222-2702.

Arrangements for hazardous waste disposal can be made by calling the North Central Solid Waste (NCSW) District at Phone: 419-228-8278. They are located at 815 Shawnee Road, Lima, OH. NCSW will charge for this service. Disposal of electronic waste such as electrical equipment, including computers, wires, cameras, printers, VCRs, DVD players, cell phones, scanners, copiers, stereos, Walkmans, iPods, MP3 players, radios, and CBs WILL BE ACCEPTED AT NO CHARGE. The charge for TV sets, Flat Screens and Monitors is \$0.60 per pound.

Serious Valley Way Park Concerns

We regret to inform you that someone is using our Valley Way Park as a dump site. The culprit(s) are dumping trash, brush, grass, pots and other waste along the edges of our park. This is so unnecessary, because these lazy bum(s) could easily dispose of this material FREE at Resource Recycling on Neubrecht Road. Also, vandals are driving vehicles into the park late at night and "Doing Donuts", which ruins our soccer field and make mowing more difficult. If you witness these violations, please get their license number and call the Sheriff's Department. If necessary, the CCHTL Trustees will take action and chain the park entrance to restrict vehicle access.

The CCHTL Trustees are making plans to improve our Valley Way Park entrances. We are discussing new signage and landscaping at Fenway Drive and Valley Way. We are also working on erosion problems along the walking path beside Lost Creek and our Valley Way entrance driveway. This summer, the Allen County Ditch Engineers will put "D" Rock along the banks of Lost Creek near our Valley Way Park walking path from the bend in the creek to the bridge. Bath Township may be able to help us deal with our Valley Way Park driveway erosion.
